Satellite Dishes and Outside Alterations

Many residents in Georgetown are installing Dishes for their TV reception these days. Before your dish is installed, you must contact Arbors to get a letter of approval. The dish must be located on the back side of the roof and NOT on the building/bricks or on the fences. It can be installed within your fenced area, tho they cannot be higher than the fence.



Any alterations to the outside of your units MUST be approved by GCLO Council. Specs for any alterations are defined in our Rules and Regs, and Council can help you decide and plan the best action to take. Please contact Tom @ Arbors Management and he can guide you through the correct process.

SCHOOL IS OUT—Lets keep our kids safe!

An excerpt from The Georgetown Express, April 1995

"......a joint gathering of GC and CC residents took place to discuss the ongoing and deteriorating issue of speeding on Georgetown Drive." The options presented were a three-way stop sign or speed bumps up to the entrance to Colony Courts. A decision for the stopsigns was made along with 15 MPH speed limit signs, but "if the problem is not controlled, Council for GCLO will act immediately to move ahead with the installation of speed bumps along Georgetown Drive (and possibly Williamsburg Drive). PLEASE SLOW DOWN!!! The lives of our children are at stake! Thank you."

That was 15 years ago—stop signs, 15 MPH signs and speed bumps were all installed to no avail. Recently an additional speed bump was installed just below the CC stop sign to hopefully help slow down traffic on Georgetown Drive. Again, in 2010, we ask all residents to PLEASE slow down and stop at the three-way stop signs. This is not intended to be an inconvenience, but an effort to keep our residents and their children safe.

Patios 'n .Landscapes

It's nice when residents plant annual flowers in the existing flower beds around patio fences and along entrance walks. Color adds a lot to the appearance of our community. Remember, items on patios may not be above or beyond the fence wall, including plants and foliage.
