

The Landscaping THINK TANK scheduled a meeting with Marra, Plum Line, Esposito, and Stevenson Landscaping Companies for them to present plans and costs for revamping





Marra's came well prepared with folders, before and after pictures, detailed information in writing as well as a good verbal presentation. They had lots of professional information to share, and their prices were very reasonable.

Plum Line Nursery did not show up as scheduled—this was not a good thing.

Esposito gave us lists of plants he would consider using, and though he did show landscape plans at the meeting, he did not have copies for us to keep and study. The prices were the highest, though the number of plants to be used was extensive.

Stevenson's had copies of drawings showing where plants would be placed and listed what the plants were. He also had 3-D designs showing the completed projects. His plans showed a minimal number of plants, and his prices were the lowest.

We had three very different ideas, which is good for making comparisons and getting some very diversified ideas. All three presentations had color, low maintenance and consistency throughout Georgetown. Replacing the fences (research is in progress) is a major consideration in how the plans can be put into effect. Please understand how much research has to be done before any final plans can be made. THINK TANK is working hard to pull this all together. We have a long way to go, but don't mind because when it happens, it will be great!

FYI: The celebration of Groundhog Day began with Pennsylvania's earliest settlers. They brought with them the legend of Candlemas Day, which states, "For as the sun shines on Candlemas Day, so far will the snow swirl in May..."

Punxsutawney held its first Groundhog Day in the 1800s. The first official trek to Gobbler's Knob was made on February 2, 1887. So the story goes, Punxsutawney Phil was named after King Phillip. Prior to being called Phil, he was called Br'er Groundhog. If Punxsutawney Phil sees his shadow, there will be six more weeks of winter weather. If he does not see his shadow, there will be an early spring.
